- Photograph your bicycles and keep the serial number noted and safe
- Always lock your bike up safe, look to spend about 10% of what the bike is worth on the lock
- Insure your bike
- Security mark the frame with a UV pen
- Ensure if that if your bike is kept in the shed that the shed is also kept secure
